Hayter Engineering assisted Lamar County Water Supply District in obtaining funding for this project through the Texas Water Development Board Drinking Water State Revolving Fund.

Projects included System 7 waterline improvements from Toco to Roxton, Roxton and High Standpipe Mixers, and waterline improvements FM 137 Roxton to Howland.

This project replaced two 2-1/2" line segments in the system that were significantly undersized for the number of customers being served, the length of the lines, and their locations within the pressure plane.

Installation included approximately 16,070 LF of 4" SDR 21 Class 200 PVC water line.
