Hayter Engineering assisted the City of Paris for a TxDOT Safe Routes to Schools grant. This project includes sidewalks for the neighborhoods for children on their way to Justiss Elementary which is on the west side of Paris, and Crocket Middle School on the east side of Paris, Texas.

To date 1,068 LF of existing 4' wide sidewalk has been removed and disposed of; 3,683 LF of 4' wide 4" concrete sidewalks (including 5'x5' passing spaces every 200 LF) have been installed; 1,749 LF of 5', 8', 10', and 12' wide concrete sidewalks have been installed; one crossing bridge structure; and 342 SY 5" concrete driveway replacement.

Services provided by Hayter Engineering are listed at right.

The completed project will include additional sidewalks, crosswalks, curb ramps, curb and gutter; a pedestrian bike trail, bike lane, signage, retaining wall, drainage structures, and landscaping improvements.

Phase I of this project was completed in 2015.
